We are the expert team in the University Library focused on helping researchers with Open Access publishing, bibliometrics, researcher identities, research data management, open research practices and Digital Humanities. Our services are for researchers at all stages of the research lifecycle, from design to publication and archiving. Researchers meet us through one-to-one consultations, bespoke sessions at school and research division meetings and through in-person and online training.

We manage the publications repository, CentAUR, the Research Data Archive, REDCap, the University's funds for Open Access publishing and the Digital Humanities Hub. We support the University's research policies, planning and infrastructure and we enable researchers to meet the policy requirements of the Government, funders, and REF.
